Footnote:

The time allocated to each speaker will normally be limited to three minutes but may be modified by the Board Chairman depending on the numbers of speakers. This is not a period for the Board to respond to questions or comments from the public, nor is it a time for dialogue between members of the public; however, if one or more Directors desire to question any of the speakers to clarify or seek a better understand of the speaker’s comments, time will be permitted for this purpose.
